<div>B2-1</div> <div>Advanced 1</div>	<div>PRODUCTION: Can understand detailed instructions for making different kinds of transactions online./ Can comment on factual information within their field of interest.</div>
	<div>COMPREHENSION: Can identify the main conclusions in a text that presents and contrasts arguments in a clearly signalled way./ Can take notes to record the main points raised during meetings on familiar topics.</div>
<div>B2-2</div> <div>Advanced 2</div>	<div>PRODUCTION: Can describe the plot of a book or film in some detail./ Can relate information in a presentation to the same information given in graphs, charts and tables.</div>
	<div>COMPREHENSION: Can identify the main reasons for and against an argument or idea in a discussion delivered in clear standard speech. / Can understand most of a radio programme about a familiar topic.</div>
<div>B2-3</div> <div>Advanced 3</div>	<div>PRODUCTION: Can tell a short story about something funny or interesting that has happened, including detail to maintain the listener's interest./ Can describe people's personality and emotions in some detail.</div>
	<div>COMPREHENSION: Can recognise that a speaker is expressing concerns in a formal discussion. / Can distinguish between relevant and irrelevant content in extended informal speech.</div>
<div>B2-4</div> <div>Advanced 4</div>	<div>PRODUCTION: Can describe an everyday consumer-related problem and request a correction or solution / Can give the advantages and disadvantages of various options on a topical issue.</div>
	<div>COMPREHENSION: Can make inferences or predictions about the content of newspaper and magazine articles from headings, titles or headlines. / Can understand scripted speech delivered quickly, if the accent is familiar.</div>
<div>B2-5</div> <div>Advanced 5</div>	<div>PRODUCTION: Can express an inference or assumption about a person's mood or emotional state./ Can talk about possibilities in the past with precision.</div>
	<div>COMPREHENSION: Can distinguish supporting details from the main points in a text. / Can follow the stages of a complex process described using non-technical language.</div>
<div>B2-6</div> <div>Advanced 6</div>	<div>PRODUCTION: Can show interest and appreciation in conversation using a range of expressions./ Can describe future plans and intentions in detail, giving degrees of probability.</div>
	<div>COMPREHENSION: Can follow changes of topic in factual TV news items and form an idea of the main content. / Can recognize when examples are being given in a structured presentation on an unfamiliar topic.</div>
